New EHF Delegates for the 2014/15 season

Dear handball friends,

The European Handball Federation accepted new EHF-Delegates two years ago for the 2012/13 season and also introduced a new on line registration system at that time. There was no need for new delegates one year ago, so we did not have a registration period and consequently there were no new delegates prior to the 2013/14 season.

However, following various talks within the Technical Commissions of the EHF there will be a registration procedure again in view to the 2014/15 season and the EHF will accept new delegates.

The registration will again be offered on line with a form that needs to be filled in and sent to the EHF by each person who is newly interested in the position of an EHF delegate for the 2014/15 season. The registration as an EHF delegate is not limited to a certain group of persons and the present information is sent to National Federations as well as to all those persons that expressed the respective interest during the season.

We therefore kindly ask all EHF Member Federations to spread these documents within the groups and parties concerned in the Federation without any delay and make the respective information available accordingly.

As it was the case two years ago the on-line registration form will ask for standard personal data as well as information regarding the handball career of the applicant including his/her involvement in clubs and federations. In order to come to a complete picture of the applicant, a live video must be included with a personal message of the applicant and a photo must be uploaded as well.

Furthermore please remember the age limit for new delegates which is 55 years, therefore an application is only possible for persons who are born on 1 July 1959 or later.

Since there is already a good number of active delegates the EHF will only accept a maximum of twenty new delegates during this registration procedure. It is therefore important for all applicants to also be prepared that the application will be rejected as others will be accepted.

The on line registration will open on 4 June 2014 and will close on 22 June 2014.

Once the registered candidates passed a first evaluation successfully they will be invited to participate in an education as well as testing seminar in Vienna at the end of August 2014.

Most important information and facts regarding the issue of new EHF-Delegates for the 2014/15 season

Who can register to become an EHF-delegate?

Basically any person. Of course, a certain relation to the duties and requirements of an EHF-delegate are needed, e.g. the knowledge of the "Handball Rules of the Game" are a must!

Is there an age limit for applicants?

Yes, an application is only possible for persons born on 1 July 1959 or later

When is the on-line registration open?

From 4 June 2014 to 22 June 2014

What is needed for a completed registration?

- 1 Fill in the on line form
- 2 upload a video with a personal message regarding your reasons and thoughts why to become an EHF-delegate
- 3 upload a current photo

When does the EHF inform about the evaluation of the registration?

On 7 July 2014 the latest

When and where is the seminar for those applicants that are accepted?

On 30/31 August in Vienna (Gartenhotel "Altmannsdorf")
Arrival Saturday before 13.00 hrs., Departure Sunday after 13.00 hrs.

How is the cost situation at the seminar?

Applicants pay the travel to and from the seminar location
EHF pays all costs for board and lodging during the seminar

How many applicants will be accepted?

A maximum of 20 (twenty) applicants will be accepted for the seminar
